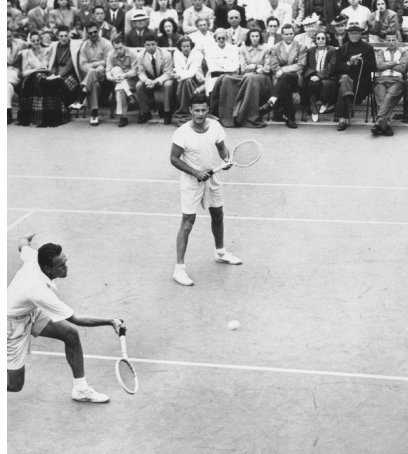

La Jolla Beach & Tennis Club is a fifth-generation, family-owned and operated company dedicated to the operation of a 21-acre beachside resort. The resort encompasses three properties, including the exclusive 90-room La Jolla Beach & Tennis Club, the 128-room La Jolla Shores Hotel and the award-winning Marine Room restaurant. Resort amenities include 13 championship tennis courts, 5 pickleball courts, a nine-hole Par-3 golf course, two swimming pools, three oceanfront restaurants and cocktail lounges, and one of Southern California's only private beaches.

## HISTORY AND RENOVATION

---

### A STORIED HISTORY

- In April 1926, a group of prominent businessmen, including Fredrick William Kellogg (FWK), envisioned the La Jolla Beach and Yacht Club.
- They acquired 14 acres along what is now La Jolla Shores,
- Founded on July 22, 1927
- On May 23, 1935, FWK and Florence Scripps Kellogg purchased the property and renamed it "The Beach Club at La Jolla, Inc."
- Inspired by his son's love for tennis, FWK added four tennis courts and an Olympic-size pool, renaming it again as the La Jolla Beach & Tennis Club.
- FWK passed away on September 4, 1940, during a trans-Pacific cruise to Japan, just before the opening of the Marine Room.
- His son, William Scripps Kellogg (WSK), took over, completing the Marine Room and adding a nine-hole par-3 golf course.
- In 1973, WSK retired, passing leadership to his son, William Crowe Kellogg, who expanded tennis facilities and led extensive renovations.
- Today, the Club, the Marine Room, and La Jolla Shores Hotel are managed by the fifth generation of Kelloggs.
- William "Bill" J. Kellogg serves as president, maintaining the Club's legacy as a family-owned, independent destination.

- Fees apply to all guests | Guests are limited to four (4) guests per room

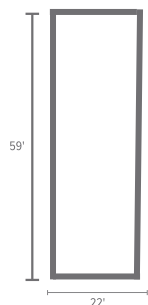
## Event Space

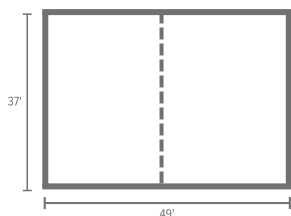
### The Walnut Lounge

Ocean view and stately fireplace impart a feeling of genuine warmth.



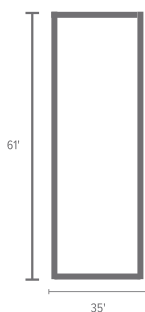
### La Sala

Our poolside patio, located next to La Sala in the heart of the club, offers a beautiful setting for your outdoor gathering.



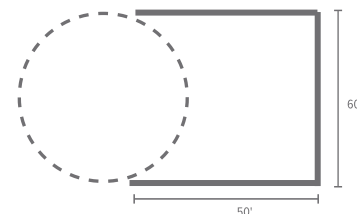
### Beach
